

**PARK PLAZAS COMMUNITY SERVICES ASSOCIATION
COMMUNITY GARDEN TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Both organic and non-organic gardening is permissible. Toxic pesticides, weed killers, etc. are not allowed in the Community Garden except as a last resort to combating garden pests.
2. All produce grown is strictly for personal use only unless designated for a charitable cause.
3. No pets of any kind are allowed within the confines of the garden area.
4. Water delivery for each bed will be on a set schedule and controlled by a timer system. The only variance will be the number of drip heads each gardener chooses to use of the twelve provided for each bed.
5. Each gardener agrees to pay the Seasonal Fee of \$25, as well as agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth in this document.
6. Access to the garden will be via a locked gate. Participants will be given a key in exchange for a \$25 deposit, refundable when the participant no longer wishes to use the garden and has returned their plot(s) to the condition it/they were in when assigned to them.
7. PPCSA will provide appropriate signage for the garden area as well as a participant communication board, as necessary.
8. All participants will insure that weeds, trash, and litter are kept out of the Community Garden.
9. All participants will contribute to spring/fall preparation/cleanup of the Community Garden.
10. There will be no refunds of seasonal fees paid. However, if a participant adopts a bed after the growing season has started, the seasonal fee may be pro-rated.
11. All participants must provide complete contact information (phone, email, address).
12. If a participant wishes to cease gardening his/her garden plot, the intent to do so must be communicated in writing to garden supervisory staff.
13. Participants agree to hold PPCSA and other participants harmless for the use of the garden area. Damage to the gardener's bed from insects, insecticides, fertilizers, or any other reason shall not be deemed to have been incurred due to the fault of another gardener or PPCSA.
14. Participants shall plant, cultivate, and harvest garden plots at their own risk, and each individual shall assume any and all risk of loss for any reason.
15. Participants shall be aware of the possible presence of children in the Cisne cul-de-sac and agree to park in the parking area directly accessible from Plaza Blanca and to the north of the Cisne cul-de-sac whenever it is practical.
16. By signing the Community Garden Terms and Conditions, each participant agrees to hold PPCSA free of any legal liability for activities associated with the garden. PPCSA reserves the right to terminate the Community Garden activities for any reason it deems appropriate.
